Credit System	Total amount of studies is measured in credit points (ECTS). One ECTS corresponds to 26 hours of studies performed by a student. One academic year consists of 60 ECTS. Courses in all subjects must end with an examination or a preliminary examination. There may be several independent examinations in separate parts of a subject.
Grading Scheme	 We use two types of assessment: differentiated and non- differentiated <u>Differentiated assessment</u> of academic results of students in a subject or its parts is conducted using a six-grade assessment system (supplemented by the verbal counterpart and the description of meaning of every grade) as follows: Grade "A" - "Excellent"; Grade "B" - "Very good"; Grade "C" - "Good"; Grade "C" - "Good"; Grade "E" - "Sufficient"; Grade "F" - "Insufficient"; Grade "F" - "Insufficient"; The examination or preliminary examination is considered passed upon its grading in the range from "E" to "A". In calculating the average grade the following correspondences are applied: A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1, F=0. Non-differentiated assessment of academic results is conducted using a system whereby the positive result is defined as "Pass" and the negative result as "Fail".
