Theme and Objectives

ICT, sustainability and governance are providing innovations in planning that concern education, practice and government.

This seminar is intended to discuss how scholars, professionals and administrators can direct their efforts in order to face the thrust for innovation. The main subjects are the implementations of the new technologies (as GIS), the change in the environmental perspective and the expectations of the local communities for decisions assumed on a larger basis.

Structure

The Seminar starts on Thursday and ends on Saturday evening; it consists of three Sessions:

- Education
- Practice
- Institutions.

Each Session has its own Rapporteur (every association provide one of the Rapporteur); Participants attend all the Sessions.

Each Session takes half a day and is made of three parts.

Part 1: *plenary meeting*; a speech is released by the Session Rapporteur.

Part 2: *three distinct workshops*, all of them dealing with the themes pointed out by the Session Rapporteur from the point of view of:

- Information and Communication Technologies;
- Environmental Issues;
- Governance.

The Participants are previously divided into well balanced groups (the members of the groups should change every Session, to enhance mutual acquaintance); every workshop is led by a Facilitator, already chosen (by the Scientific Committee) among the Participants.

After the workshops, a separate discussion takes place in which the Facilitators meet the Rapporteur in order to collect the results of the three workshops.

Part 3: all the Participants gather again in the same room; synthesis by the Rapporteur and final discussion.

Preparatory papers

The Rapporteurs are expected to send a position paper, in order to allow the Facilitators to prepare the seminar work.

All the participants are invited to prepare a scheme of the situation in their country and in their field on the seminar subjects and take this with them digitally and as a hard copy. These preparatory papers *must not* be sent to the ISoCaRP Secretariat. The presentation of the preparatory papers is not on the seminar schedule; participants will however have the opportunity to use the papers in the discussions.

Technical tours

The Participants are invited to technical tours organised by the Local Institutions and Agencies (Regione Liguria, Provincia di Genova, Porto Antico s.p.a.); innovation in planning practices, environmental and urban rehabilitation are the general subjects of the tours.

On Sunday the Seminar participants and their accompanying persons will have the opportunity to visit the Cinqueterre National Park, accompanied by the authors of the Plan of the Park (whole day excursion, travel by train).

Related events
